Students usually undertake three semesters per year, rather than two, as is the case in other universi-

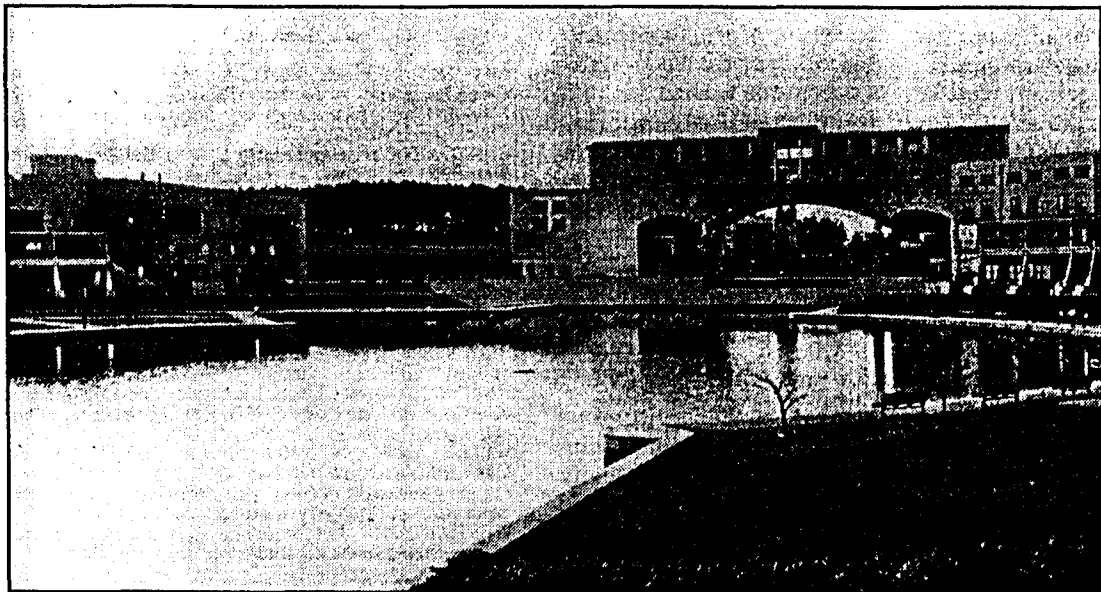
ties, which means that most graduate qualifications can be gained in two rather than three years.
